After 3-years of study, the National Institute for Standards and Technology (NIST) released the findings of their investigation into the collapse of the World Trade Center Towers last October, which contained 30 recommendations for enhancing public safety in tall buildings. The recommendations are broad and may impact the design of all buildings. The recommendations and their implementation are currently being debated in different forums including the SEI Board of Governors.
